

The Foundation of the Catholic Diocese of Raleigh hosted members of the Father Thomas Price Legacy Society on Tuesday, October 21, for Mass and lunch with Bishop Luis Zarama.

The annual event recognizes individuals who have included provisions for a parish, school, Catholic Charities or other diocesan ministries in their estate plans.

The organization currently oversees 181 endowments with assets totaling \$91 million, up from \$61 million three years ago.

In the past fiscal year, the Foundation granted \$1.7 million to the diocese — a 15% increase — along with \$361,000 to parishes and schools and \$137,600 to Catholic Charities.
